AMERICA'S FIRST FLAG

"THE REBELLIOUS STRIPES"



Planted on Flag Day, June 14, 2019,
by the Boston Historical Society.

One morning, August 1765, Boston awoke to find a huge flag flying from their Liberty Tree. Measuring 17 ft. with a stripe for each colony protesting the Stamp Act, Sons of Liberty named it "Rebellious Stripes."

"WHERE THE REVOLUTION BEGAN"




Planted 8/14/2019 by Sons of Liberty-Lake
